Are you a current counseling student committed to providing addiction counseling services to underserved and underrepresented communities? You may be eligible for one of 40 master's-level addiction counseling fellowships through the NBCC Minority Fellowship Program (MFP).

Each **\$15,000 fellowship** includes a sustainability package with access to mentors, professional resources, and much more.

Basic Eligibility

- ◆ Applicants must be a U.S. citizen or have permanent resident status.
- ◆ Applicants must not already possess a master's degree in a behavioral health field.
- ◆ Applicants must not receive any other federal program training funds (except for federal loans or work-study programs).
