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Why an “Integration” Institute?

- Initial rounds of “integration” included mental health and primary care
- Prevalence of addictive disorders in primary care is high and often goes undiagnosed
- Section 2703 of the Affordable Care Act – Health Homes
- Emerging, identified co-morbidity between addiction and diabetes

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What difference did we make?

- ADMP was able to identify and FQHC and a substance abuse provider and provide start up costs
- Richmond Behavioral Health was able to expand primary care services at a newly acquired residential substance use disorders facility
- The Bridge Behavioral Health obtained a physician from their local FQHC daily for 2 hours
- Berks Counseling Center implemented an on-site pharmacy and lab and health screenings and wellness supports for all clients
- St Vincent DePaul Health Center saw 69% of our mental health patients were seen by a PCP within 30 days of the referral.
