### Highlights

More than two thousand students are enrolled in Eastfield's substance abuse and social work courses.

- All substance abuse and social work courses are offered online.
- Seventy percent of the students are minorities. The vast majority are African-American and Hispanic.
- Faculty members are multi-cultural and bilingual and all hold licenses in their respected disciplines.
- Partnerships are in place with local universities for students transferring into four-year colleges to obtain their bachelor's and master's degrees.
- We have an eighty-five percent retention rate.
- Most of our graduates are hired by local treatment agencies.
- Eastfield students update Dallas-Ft. Worth legislators on substance abuse issues during each legislative session.
- Three students are also board members of the Texas Association of Addiction Professionals.
- Students conduct practicum internships in local treatment agencies.
- Eastfield is the training location for the first certified Peer Recovery Support Specialist training program provided in Texas by the Associations of Persons Affected by Addiction.
