Highlights

- Our student body is historically eighty-two percent minority and is more than sixty percent African-American.
- After participating in practicums, our students say they truly understand how much better trained they are than students coming out of other area programs.
- Practicum sites tell us there is a distinct difference between our students and other students, even compared to students from master's degree programs. Our students are computer literate and integrate into practicum settings quickly.
- Our faculty members are very involved in the community
- We are the only school in Texas that has the Community Health Worker certification program as part of a degree program.
- We will be offering classes as part of Child Advocacy Studies Training from the National Childhood Protection Training Center. We are only the second community college in the U.S. to offer the training and the second school in Texas to offer it.
