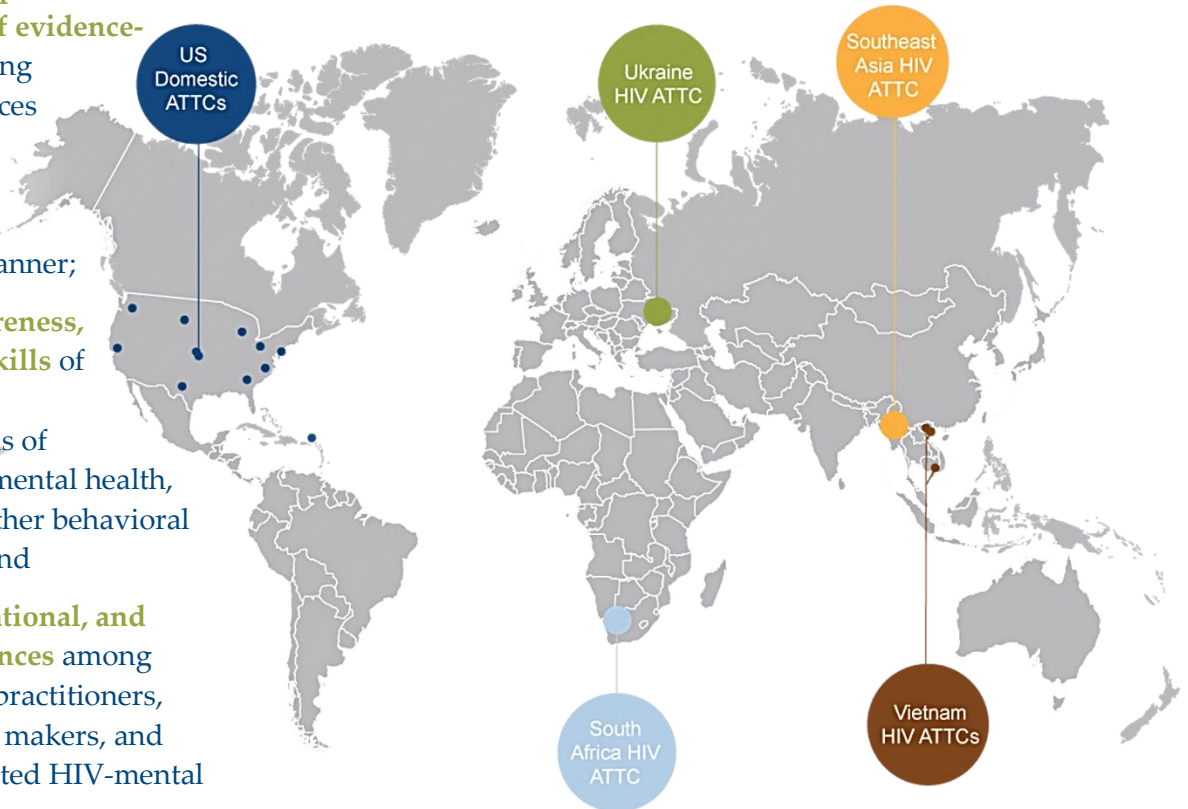
Who We Are
