




Matrix Treatment Components

- Individual Sessions
- Early Recovery Groups
- Relapse Prevention Groups
- Family Education Groups
- 12-Step Meetings
- Social Support Groups
- Relapse Analysis
- Drug Testing








Matrix 'Sample' Schedule

Early Recovery Skills Weeks 1-4 6:00-7:00	Family Education Weeks 1-12 6:00-7:30	Early Recovery Skills Weeks 1-4 6:00-7:00
Relapse Prevention Weeks 1-16 7:00-8:30	Social Support Weeks 13-16 7:00-8:00	Relapse Prevention Weeks 1-16 7:00-8:30







Implementation Considerations

Individual/Conjoint Sessions

- Involving family members in conjoint sessions
- Culture considerations
- Skills working with families

Early Recovery Groups/Relapse Prevention

- Securing co-leaders for early recovery groups
- Counselor's skills for delivering psycho-educational groups that are based on a manualized approach.







More Implementation Considerations

Family Education Sessions

- Engaging family and supportive others in family education groups
- Videos are helpful for families and clients


Social Support Groups

- Difficult to initiate these groups without individuals who have been in long-term recovery.
- Opportunity to build a positive social support and stay connected with group members.

Clinical versus mandatory








Lessons Learned

- ✓ Creating staff-buy in essential champions!!!
- ✓ Involving community partners in the implementation process can be very helpful
- ✓ Motivational Interviewing is an important foundational skill
- ✓ Need a strong clinical supervisor to support skills development and on-going training
- ✓ Group dynamics affected when all group members primary diagnosis is stimulant use disorder only.
- ✓ Gender-specific groups
- ✓ "Use a change management strategy and hold the course."






Hard copies can be purchased and includes the 3 key videos which cover core concepts.




