

The contingency management incentive examples below were provided by SAMSHA’s Tribal Opioid Response (TOR) grantees and include American Indian/Alaska Native-specific and more general ideas.

<b>AI/AN-Specific Contingency Management Incentive Ideas (TOR Grantee Suggestions)</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wild Rice</li> <li>• Wild rice knockers</li> <li>• Traditional maple syrup</li> <li>• Fry bread mix</li> <li>• Other local tribal foods (processed)</li> </ul>	Art and/or drum supplies (may help when offer social enterprise opportunities)
Smudge kits	Beads and/or beading supplies
Sweetgrass, kinnikinic/traditional tobacco, sage	Pendleton Towels
Abalone shell and sage, cedar or sweetgrass	Blankets
Free tilling and planting	Fur lined boots in cold climates (AK)
Seeds for planting	Hand warmers (AK)
Fishing supplies	Coffee mugs with Native designs
Training on how to harvest and prepare cedar and sage	Deer/Elk jerky (cured meat)

<b>Other Contingency Management Incentive Ideas (TOR Grantee Suggestions)</b>	
Gas cards	Housing vouchers or first month’s rent
Grocery gift cards	Movie ticket for depositing medication during drug take back event (attend outdoor movie during COVID)
Phone cards (purchase minutes)	“Return your pill so you don’t get ill” an incentive program created by a grantee (bring in 10 pills get gift card, 80 pills receive a prepaid phone, 50 pills receive a gas card, 150 pills receive a big screen TV); contingency management allowed grantee to get count of pills and statistics on what was turned in at drug take back location; once data collected will let public know what was turned in.
