# No-Cost Extension

FY19 grantees may request a NCE if additional time is needed to ensure completion of the originally approved project, and/or to permit an orderly phase-out of project objectives.

- One-time extension of up to 12 months.
- Request for NCE must be submitted no later than 60 days prior to the Project Period end date (No later than 7/31/2021).
- Request must be submitted through eRA Commons.
- If no NCE is submitted, then the project end date is 9/29/2021, and grantee should prepare for closeout.

# FY19 TOR Grant Closeout

- The project period for the FY19 TOR grant ends on September 29, 2021. Grantees who will not be submitting no-cost extensions should prepare for grant closeout. Recipients must complete all actions required for closeout to include:
  - Reconcile financial expenditures associated with the award.
  - Liquidate all obligations incurred under the award.
  - Submit to the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) [Payment Management System \(PMS\)](#) the final quarterly [Federal Cash Transactions Report \(FCTR\)](#).
  - Return any funds due to [PMS](#) as a result of refunds, corrections, or audits.
- **Complete and submit the three required reports no later than ninety (120) days after the end of award:**
  - Final Financial Report (FFR)
  - Final Progress Report (FPR)
  - Tangible Personal Property Report (TPPR)

## Fentanyl Test Strips

- SAMHSA TOR grantees may now use grant funds to purchase fentanyl test strips as a harm reduction measure.

# GPRA Client-Level Data Collection

- Client-level data collection is required for all clients receiving treatment or recovery services. Not required for prevention activities.
- Data collection is required at:
  1. Baseline (Intake)
  2. Six-month follow-up (to be completed between months 5 and 8)
  3. Discharge
- Six-month follow-up interviews are required for every client regardless of discharge status (i.e. complete, dropout).
- GPRA data gets uploaded into [SPARS](#).
