TOR Grant Closeout

- The project period for FY18 no-cost extensions and FY19 TOR grants complete all actions required for closeout including: ends on September 29, 2021. Grantees who will be ending must
- Complete and submit the three required reports no later than ninety (120) days after the end of award:
- 1. Final Financial Report (FFR)
- Final Progress Report (FPR)
- 3. Tangible Personal Property Report (TPPR)
- Submit any outstanding GPRA data into SPARS
- Email with closeout instructions sent on August 31, 2021.



Annual Progress Reports

- TOR Annual Progress Reports are due by 12/31/21.

- Report format sent via email on 9/20/21.
- Grantees should upload completed report to eRA under "Performance Progress Report."



Carryover and FFR Submission

- 2021. forward unspent funds from YR1 to YR2. FY20 TOR grantees may request to carry Requests for carryover due by December 31,
- Federal Financial Report (SF-425) also due by December 31, 2021.
- Instructions sent via email on 9/20/21.



Supplemental Awards

9/3. Responses due by October 30, 2021: Notices of award sent out from eRA Commons on 9/2 or FY20 TOR grantees received supplemental TOR funding.

GPRA Client-Level Data Collection

- activities Client-level data collection is required for all clients receiving treatment or recovery services. Not required for prevention
- Data collection is required at:
- Baseline (Intake)
- Six-month follow-up (to be completed between months 5 and 8)
- Discharge
- Six-month follow-up interviews are required for every client regardless of discharge status (i.e. complete, dropout).
- GPRA data gets uploaded into **SPARS**.
