SAMHSA TOR GPO Updates

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TOR Grant Closeout

- The project period for FY18 no-cost extensions and FY19 TOR grants ended on September 29, 2021. Grantees who have ended must complete all actions required for closeout including:
 - Complete and submit the <u>three</u> required reports no later than ninety (120) days after the end of award:
 - 1. Final Financial Report (FFR)
 - 2. Final Progress Report (FPR)
 - 3. Tangible Personal Property Report (TPPR)
 - Submit any outstanding GPRA data into SPARS.
- Email with closeout instructions sent on August 31, 2021.





Mid-Year Progress Reports

- TOR Mid-Year Progress Reports will be due by 04/30/22. (Unless in NCE)
- Report summarizing activities over the period from 09/30/21 to 03/31/22.
- Report format sent via email.
- Grantees should upload completed report to eRA under "Performance Progress Report" (FY20) or "Multi-Year Programmatic Report" (FY21).





GPRA SOR-TOR Program Instrument

- Updated SAMHSA SOR-TOR Program Instrument went into effect on 04/01/22.
- Replaces previous 3-question naloxone tool.
- Training held on 04/06/22. Recording link will be sent.
- Updated instrument collects data on (1) overdose reversal, (2) fentanyl test strips purchased and distributed, (3) education of school-aged children, first responders, and key community sectors on opioid and/or stimulant misuse, and (4) outreach activities that target underserved and/or diverse populations.



GPRA Client-Level Data Collection

- Client-level data collection is required for all clients receiving treatment or recovery services. Not required for prevention activities.
- Data collection is required at:
 - 1. Baseline (Intake)
 - 2. Six-month follow-up (to be completed between months 5 and 8)
 - 3. Discharge
- Six-month follow-up interviews are required for every client regardless of discharge status (i.e. complete, dropout).
- GPRA data gets uploaded into <u>SPARS.</u>
