Hmong Culture and Alcohol


 Alcohol is an integral part of Hmong wedding negotiations, wedding ceremonies, social occasions, and religious/spiritual rituals.

- Trauma PTSD
- Mental Health
 - Depression
 - Little support and lack of understanding from the community
- Life events (e.g., divorce, death, losing a job)
- Peer pressure





Needs in Our Community



- Make services accessible to the Hmong Community
- Have more culturally competent providers
- Have more culturally appropriate services
- Community outreach and education on alcoholism and the effects of alcohol
- Materials (e.g., videos, brochures) in Hmong
- Encourage and support the education and licensing of Hmong Professions in these fields (MH/AODA)
- Collect better data to make more informed decisions
