Harm Reduction Philosophy

Respect and dignity for individuals who use drugs

- Does not minimize or ignore harm
- Empowers people to live healthier lives
- Shift away from abstinence only to include safer behavior or reduction in behavior
- Meets people where they are at, but does not leave them there




Harm Reduction in Idaho



In 2021...

- 633,674 sterile syringes distributed to participants
- 5,192 naloxone or NARCAN kits distributed to PWUD or their friends and family
- 628 opioid related overdose reversals reported
- 964 unique participants across 34 counties




SUPPLIES:

- Overdose prevention education

Sterile Syringe Access

"Needs based"

- Reduces barriers to access
- Greater reduction in HIV HCV transmission
- Best Practice

"Syringe Exchange"

- Barriers to access
- Undermines HR values
- Better than nothing!

Availability of Appropriate Syringes

best

Use as small a needle gauge as possible

smaller hole = smaller wound = reduced healing time

ok

Continue the injection practice that is most comfortable and reliable, using the appropriate syringe size

please **avoid** Changing to inappropriate and ineffective syringe sizes that cause an increase in the amount of injections



Other essentials: Sterile Water

best

Sterile water/saline strips (Addipaks), sealed bottled water, or boiled water

ok

Opened bottles of water, tap water, water from back of toilet

please **avoid** Water from front of toilet, puddle/gutter water





Overdose Prevention Program



- Narcan and/or Naloxone
- CPR shields for rescue breathing
- Individual participants and organizations/agencies
 - o Law enforcement
 - First responders
 - o Shelters
 - SUD tx providers
 - Others

Harm Reduction Saves Lives

Syringe Service Programs (SSPs) are an evidence-based public health intervention that is associated with

- 50% reduction in HIV and HCV incidence
- 5x more likely to enter SUD treatment
- 3x more likely to reduce or stop using drugs
- Reduce overdose deaths
- Provide an opportunity to address social determinants of health
